Computing

- Say what an algorithm is and explain why it is important to be precise when writing an algorithm.

English

- Write a fiction book based on the story Lost in the Museum.
- Compose and write sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
- Create a toy museum and write labels using adjectives.
- Write a recount based on the Christmas holidays.

Maths

Place value

- Read, write and count numbers to 100 from any given number.
- Find one more and one less than a number.
- Represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations.
- Count in multiples of twos, fives and tens.
- Partition and combine numbers using apparatus.

Addition and subtraction

- Represent & use number bonds and related subtraction facts.
- Read & write mathematical statements involving +, -, =.
- Add and subtract one and two digit numbers to 20, including 0.
- Solve one step problems.

PE

- Develop basic movements involving throwing and catching.
- Perform dances using basic movements – toy dance.

Music

- Explore beat through movement, body percussion and instruments.
- Combine steady beat with word rhythms.
- Explore changes in tempo.

Spanish

- Learn how to say the days and months of the year.
- Learn vocabulary relating to the days of the week and months of year.
- Learn about Spanish culture and the three kings. (Epiphany – culture)

Humanities

- To be able to sort old and new toys.
