- construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey

- Print on fabrics using tie-dyes or batik
- Create designs using exploded diagrams
- Use his/her knowledge of techniques and the functional and aesthetic qualities of a wide range of materials to plan how to use them

English

Reading

- Show that I enjoy reading by reading a wide range of fiction, poetry, plays, non-fiction and reference books or textbooks
- Discuss different types of poetry e.g. free verse and narrative poetry
- Discuss words and phrases in the books that I read that excite me

Writing

- Poetry- sonnets
- Playscripts and direct speech

Maths

- I can read, write and compare time between analogue and digital 12-hour and 24-hour clocks
- I can solve problems where I need to convert units of time such as hours to minutes, minutes to seconds, years to months or weeks to days
- I can round decimals using tenths to the nearest whole number
- I can estimate, compare and calculate different measures, including money in pounds and pence
- I can multiply two digit and three digit numbers by a one digit number using a formal written method

PE

Swimming

Gymnastics

- Control subtle variations in level, speed and direction

Spanish
