Physical

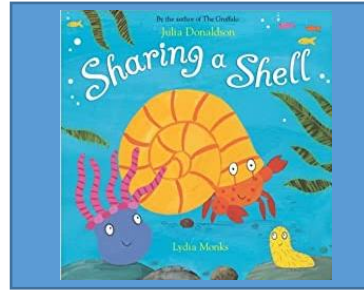
- PE- Practising ball skills e.g. throwing and catching and learning new ball games.
