Computing

- To compare the effects of adhering strictly to instructions to completing tasks without complete instructions.
- To follow and create simple instructions on the computer.
- To consider how the order of instructions affects the result.

Writing

- Writing a recount- focusing on chronological order and time connectives
- Owl babies- focusing on building suspense

Reading

- read aloud accurately books that are consistent with their developing phonic knowledge and that do not require them to use other strategies to work out words#
- re-read these books to build up their fluency and confidence in word reading.
- learning to appreciate rhymes and poems, and to recite some by heart

PE

- Develop basic movements involving throwing and catching.
- Perform dances using basic movements – toy dance.

Music

- Explore beat through movement, body percussion and instruments.
- Combine steady beat with word rhythms.
- Explore changes in tempo.

Maths

Place value

- Read, write and count numbers to 100 from any given number.
- Find one more and one less than a number.
- Represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations.
- Count in multiples of twos, fives and tens.
- Partition and combine numbers using apparatus.

Addition and subtraction

- Represent & use number bonds and related subtraction facts.
- Read & write mathematical statements involving +, -, =.
- Add and subtract one and two digit numbers to 20, including 0.
- Solve one step problems.
